Consent Conditions


As a condition of its resource consents, BHSL is required to establish a Community Liaison Group. The Community Liaison Group must be conducted in good faith and is tasked with:

- Facilitating the flow of information between BHSL and the community.
- Identifying issues of concern that arise during the construction of the storage ponds.
- Identifying appropriate measures to address issues raised.
- Making recommendations to BHSL and its contractors regarding issues raised.
- Providing annual advisory reports for residents living within the identified inundation zone.
- Ensuring that residents within the inundation zone are aware of the Community Liaison Group and the availability of assistance for preparing and updating Household Emergency Plans (as part of the Emergency Evacuation Plan).

Community Liaison Group Structure

The consent conditions specify minimum membership of the Community Liaison Group. BHSL has used this as a base for the proposed structure below:

	Stakeholder category	Member/s	Role/contribution
1	ECESS (and/or community representatives potentially impacted by storage pond breach)	3 x representatives	Represents collective interests and provides feedback and continuity
2	Local landowners/ BHSL shareholders (within 1 km of the storage ponds)	3 x representatives	Represents the local community and provides feedback
3	Residents living between the Waimakariri and Eyre rivers, south of Wrights Road and north of the Eyre River Diversion	3 x representatives	Represents the local community and provides feedback
4	Local government	2 x representatives (1 x WDC + 1 x ECan)	Provides regulatory oversight and technical input
5	Te Ngāi o Tūāhuriri Rūnanga	1 x representative	Ensure cultural values and heritage are respected
6	Consent holder	2 x project team members	Provide updates, respond to feedback, ensure compliance
7	Construction contractor	1 x project team member	Provides updates and responds to feedback regarding construction of the storage ponds
8	BHSL Community Liaison Officer (CLO)	1 x project team member	Appointed by consent holder to facilitate engagement and communication between CLG + BHSL



Community Liaison Group Meeting Schedule

- The Community Liaison Group will hold its first meeting **at 1.00pm, Wednesday 18 March in Oxford.**
- Meetings will be held both during the day and in the evening depending on the schedule.
- During the first meeting, the Community Liaison Group will elect a Chair and agree on its terms of reference.
- It is proposed that the Community Liaison Group develop meeting procedures and a code of conduct in relation to its role. It will be a requirement that members follow the meeting procedures and abide by the code of conduct.
- BHSL is calling for expressions of interest in relation to the stakeholder categories that are not representatives or appointed by the Consent Holder.
- If you represent one of the groups/individuals named in stakeholder categories 1 to 4, please fill in the attached expression of interest form.
- **Final membership will be determined by Friday 6 March** and the names of the Community Liaison Group members will be published on the BHSL website.

Expression of Interest Submissions

Where the expressions of interest for a stakeholder category exceed the number of proposed places, BHSL anticipates working in good faith with those who have expressed an interest to determine final

Community Liaison Group membership. BHSL has a strong preference for allowing any decisions in relation to final stakeholder membership to be determined by the stakeholders themselves.
